CHEF PAUL ALBRECHT AND PAUL'S RESTAURANT TO HOST THE FOOD BANK'S 'SUPPER CLUB' EVENT

-Restaurant Donates Portion of Evening's Proceeds to Atlanta's Table—

ATLANTA (October 2, 2006) — Paul's restaurant will host the Atlanta Community Food Bank's monthly dining event, *Supper Club*, on **Tuesday, Oct. 10, 2006**. *Supper Club* is a special event that provides an opportunity for Metro Atlanta to dine out once a month at specially selected restaurants, while 20 percent of the evening's proceeds benefit the prepared food rescue project of the Food Bank, *Atlanta's Table*.

Executive Chef and owner, Paul Albrecht brings passion to his menu offering a fusion of Asian and American cuisine. This spectacular two-story bistro is decorated with marble tables, dramatic lighting and burnished wall paintings. The restaurant serves dinner seven days a week and is located in Buckhead at 10 Kings Circle, Atlanta, GA 30305.

Restaurant specialties include dishes such as Chef Paul's original batter fried lobster tail, simple pan-fried or grilled Dover sole and Filet Mignon. Other menu highlights are herb crusted flounder filet, coriander apricot rubbed pork tenderloin, and vegetable tempura crusted tuna loin that comes with wasabi mashed potatoes, fried plantains and candied shiitake.
